THE NEED

Slovakia, like much of Europe, is a very post-Christian society. Students may have some contact with churches and a basic knowledge of Christianity, but few examples of what a living relationship with Jesus looks like.

EGT (Evanjelické gymnázium Tisovec) – an English-Slovak bilingual Lutheran high school in Tisovec, Slovakia – requests American teachers to support English-language instruction and Bible teaching.
